What is Keno?

Keno is a fun, easy game that is played every 3 minutes.

20 numbers are drawn from the 80 available on the Keno game grid. Match the numbers you play to the numbers drawn for a chance to win over \$1,000,000 for just \$1!

What can I play?



Pick your numbers and watch the Keno game screen to see if they come up. Try your favourite numbers!



Take a chance at doubling your money by picking Heads or Tails. Or try quadrupling your money by picking Evens.



Take your Keno skills up a notch and combine multiple entries into one.



Make it easy by letting Keno pick your numbers at random for you.

How to play

You can play on a Keno Touch machine* or on a game card following the steps below.

- 1 Grab a Keno game card
- 2 Mark your selections on the card with a pencil

Pay for your game to receive your Keno ticket, or ask for a Kwipik.

Play Keno Bonus to win more

Keno Bonus gives you the chance to multiply your regular Keno prize by x2, x3, x4, x5 or x10! The cost of each game will double when you nominate to play Keno Bonus.

Possible bonus multiplier

To play Keno Bonus, simply select the box marked **B** at the bottom of your Keno ticket.

bonus To multiply your win up to 10x more, mark the box!



Look for the Keno Bonus animation at the start of each game to see how much your winnings will be multiplied by.

Keno Bonus multiplier does not apply directly to Keno Jackpots. See below for details on how the multiplier is applied to Keno Jackpots.



How does it work?

Once you've got your ticket, simply wait until your game appears on screen. Match the numbers on your ticket to the numbers on the Keno game screen to win!

- ▶ Game number
- ▶ Bonus
- ▶ Heads or Tails count
- ▶ Keno game grid

The Keno game screen




Don't forget you can check the game results at keno.com.au

Your ticket will tell you...

- ▶ Your selected numbers
- ▶ How many numbers you've picked
- ▶ First game
- ▶ Last game

Make sure you scan your ticket after all your games have played to check if you've won!

Want to play the same numbers again? Simply hand in your ticket and ask to Replay, or scan your ticket at a Keno Touch machine* and select Replay.

KENO Heads or Tails

A chance to double your money

Keno Heads or Tails is an easy game where you have the chance to double, or even quadruple your money. Simply pick which half of the Keno grid will have more numbers appear, or choose equal numbers in each half.

Game	Match	\$1 Could Win
Heads	More numbers drawn in top half of Keno game grid	\$2
Evens	Equal numbers drawn in top & bottom halves of Keno game grid	\$4
Tails	More numbers drawn in bottom half of Keno game grid	\$2

How to play

You can play on a Keno Touch machine* or on a game card, following the steps below.

- Grab a Keno Heads or Tails game card
- Mark your selections on the card with a pencil



Mark your selections this way

A Select game – mark one box only

Heads More numbers drawn in top half of Keno game grid

Evens Equal numbers drawn in top & bottom halves of Keno game grid

Tails More numbers drawn in bottom half of Keno game grid



How to play advanced

Multiple entries on one ticket

Multiple entries in each game can be played on one ticket. Simply grab a Keno Advanced game card for more chances to win! Combinations are created by combining groups of numbers.



To do this, simply mark your first group of numbers with the letter A (instead of the usual cross).

The second group of numbers is then marked with a B, the third with a C and so on. Just remember, you can't use the same number in more than one group.

Each combination represents one single entry. It is the amount of numbers correctly matched in each combination that determines your prize, not the total amount of numbers matched on the ticket.

- Mark your first group of numbers with the letter A. The second group is marked with B and so on.
- Mark the 'ALL' box to select all possible combinations (in this case two combinations of 3 numbers and one combination of 6) or mark the relevant numbered boxes to choose which combinations you want to play (for example, cross 3 to play two 3 number games).
- Mark the amount you want to spend per combination.
- Mark the number of games you want to play.

EXAMPLE: Play 3 combinations at \$1 per combination for 5 games – your Keno ticket will cost you \$15.

Don't forget to play Keno Bonus for your chance to multiply your win x2, x3, x4, x5 or x10!

You can play Keno Advanced for less than \$1 per game.

Minimum bet per combination for Jackpots is \$1, and the minimum ticket cost is \$1.

Know your odds

Keno is conducted under a licence issued by the State and as such, must comply with the appropriate legislation governing the operation of the game.

Players must be at least 18 years of age to participate in a game of Keno. Total ticket value must equal at least \$1.

Keno Agents have set payout limits, which determine the amount of Keno winnings to be paid as cash to the customer, with any balance paid via cheque.

Game results are available from the Keno Agent or online at keno.com.au. Please also check the Keno game screens available at all Keno Agents for game results.

When a ticket is presented for payment on the day of purchase, any outstanding unplayed games will be cancelled and refunded.

Winnings are paid on the presentation of the printed receipt ticket only. It is your responsibility to check your Keno ticket for completeness and accuracy before the commencement of the game as the payment of wins is based upon the numbers on the printed receipt ticket. The Keno operator is not liable for a player's failure to check their Keno receipt ticket.

What are your jackpot chances?

On games where you're playing 7 to 10 numbers, you're playing to win a jackpot. If every number you choose comes up, you'll win the jackpot. The jackpots increase with each game until they are won. Check out Keno game screens for current jackpot amounts.

All jackpots are subject to sharing and abatement as per Keno Rules. Minimum bet per game for jackpots is \$1.

Responsible Gambling & Gambling Support Services
